Deadlines and General Guidelines for the SCIENCE FESTIVAL at ORCHIDEA HUNGARIAN—ENGLISH BILINGUAL KINDERGARTEN, PRIMARY AND SECONDARY SCHOOL BUDAPEST on April 28, 2023.

5 kinds of Projects are accepted:

- *scientific experiments,*
- *personal research,*
- *inventions and vulgarization of science*
- **all topics dealing with the sustainable world (science, traditions, society);**
- **Erasmus+ programme's own scientific reports;**

Categories:

Beginner scientists: grades from 4 to 5 – in maximum **10 minutes.**

Juniors : grades from 6 to 8 – in maximum **10 minutes.**

Seniors : secondary students grades from 9 to 12 – in maximum **10 minutes.**

Deadlines must be strictly respected.

GENERAL RULES FOR THE POSTERS and PRESENTATIONS:
(Beginner scientists, Juniors and Seniors):

1. The language used must be English.
2. The Power Point or Prezi must be easy to access on your USB stick.
3. Presentations have a time limit of 10 minutes (this can be discussed in advance for SEN students).

Criteria for entry

Projects should demonstrate that the student(s) has undertaken significant original work.

- Each competitor may only submit one entry to the Science Festival (SF), either as an individual or as part of a 2- or 3-person group.
- A student or a group of students can only enter a project that is carried out without any contribution from other students.
- Plagiarism is prohibited. QUOTATIONS are allowed. The project entry must be the original work of the entrant(s).
- Entry forms must be completed with all relevant information. Incomplete entry forms will not be accepted. It is the responsibility of the entrant to inform the SF-team of any change of contact details.
- The judges' decisions are final and no appeals will be heard or correspondence entered into.
- A full list of prize winners will be published on the **ORCHIDEA-school website** and in any other publications selected by the organisers.
- By entering the competition, entrants agree that their entry can appear on public display and be used on the Internet and in print to promote the competition.
